

# Remote Health Care Worker

The Senior Hub

**Title** - Remote Health Care Worker, Older Adult In-Home Services

## Primary Responsibility

Providing 100% remote telehealth services including developing a care plan, monitoring, and assisting home care clients ages sixty and over residing on the rural eastern plains of Colorado.

## General Tasks and Duties

- As an independent contractor, serve a caseload of 10 to 15 home care clients, using current telehealth practices and technology.
- Monitor daily vitals coming from wrist devices worn by home care clients and provide quality and timely responses and advice remotely.
- Communicate regularly – using the tablet device provided – with clients and their identified care circles comprised of family members, caregivers, and others.
- Compare client activities and outcomes to their care plan on a regular basis.
- Participate in required virtual trainings periodically offered by the Senior Hub project team.
- Conduct all activities (such as reporting and communicating with the Senior Hub) in the independent contractor agreement.

## Desirable Skills

- Self-motivating
- Good time management
- Able to work alone in a focused manner
- Bi-lingual (though not required)

## Minimum Requirements

- Female, age 50 or older
- Reside in the State of Colorado
- Are Black, Latino, Indigenous or a Person of Color (BIPOC)
- Have been (e.g., retired) or are working toward (in training) any of these designations: Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA), Registered Nurse (RN), Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN), Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN), Qualified Medication Administration Personnel (QMAP), medical technician, or similar roles in healthcare.

## Preferred Qualifications

- Currently have any of these designations: CNA, RN, LPN, LVN, QMAP or other.
- Comfortable, competent, and experienced using computers or tablet devices.

## **Salary**

Hourly pay rates will vary from \$18 to \$32 per hour, based on license and years of experience performing comparable work. Remote workers will be paid monthly.

## **Benefits**

- A signing stipend of \$1,250 and additional payments of \$1,250 at the 3-month and 6-month mark.
- Each remote worker will receive a laptop for conducting independent contractor business such as tracking hours worked, requesting reimbursements, and participating in virtual trainings.
- A tablet device will be provided to each remote worker so they can conduct their telehealth work with the in-home services clients.
- Training (paid at same hourly rate) will be provided on: use of the tablet device and software, how to be an independent contractor, and planning for future remote business if desired.
- Client lists will be provided so the telehealth work can promptly begin.
- After 6 months, each remote worker will be eligible to receive a special certification from a local university as a Certified Remote Home Care Worker.
- At one-year, remote worker can decide whether to continue on independent contract or start their own remote telehealth business.

## **Work Schedule**

Work schedules are flexible based on the care needs of the in-home clients. We expect 10 to 20 hours per week as a target, but this can vary based on need.
